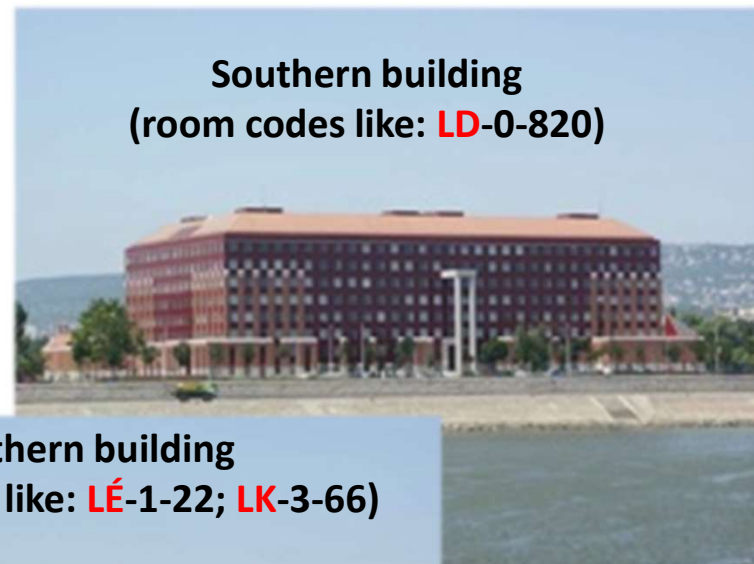

- **Lecture (exam) vs seminar (term mark)**
- **Participation** in the courses is highly recommended!
 - In some courses your lateness (even 1 minute) might be registered (3 late arrivals = 1 absence)
 - General norm: maximum 3 absence is allowed

- **Evaluation:** written or oral exam or other type of assignment set by the lecturer



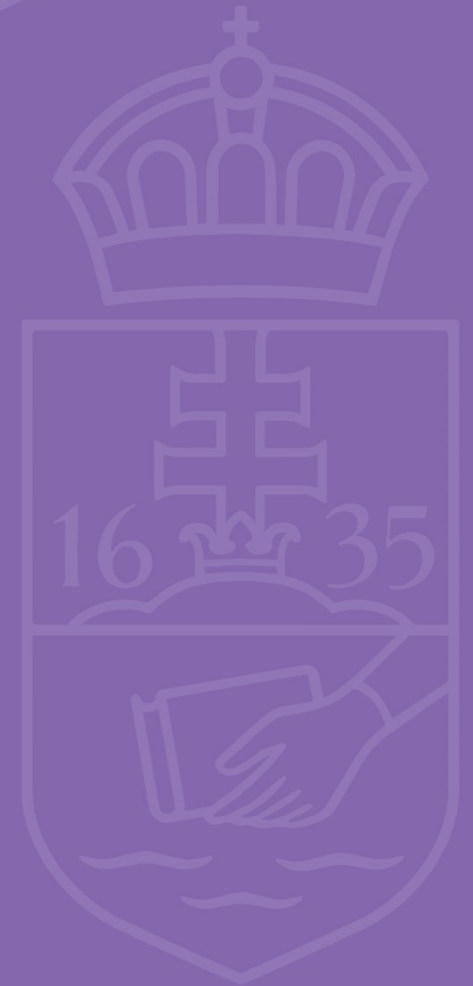
