Oktatás célja:

All anthropologists – whether applied or theoretical they may be – conducting fieldwork, find themselves in complex social situations, as their research deals with people in a variety of role relationships. Anthropologists are in connection with, and responsible to those they study, the same way as they are accountable to their field of scientific discipline, their colleagues within and outside of the field of anthropology, to the host and their own government, and to those who fund their research. The likelihood of facing several ethical problems is significant, as the anthropologist must often choose between conflicting values.

The aim of “Research Related Ethical Issues in Cultural Anthropology” course is to raise students’ awareness of the anthropologist’s responsibility: The anthropologist must make carefully considered ethical decisions, and be prepared to clarify the assumptions, facts and issues those decisions are based upon.
